


INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE ELEVATION CERTIFICATE

The Flood Insurance Manual and the Flood Insurance Application - Part 2 Worksheet contains a series of diagrams that are to be used to determine the reference level for the specific structure in question. The diagrams are available through local insurance agents or the National Flood Insurance Program.

For property located in Flood Zone A, the reference level is the lowest of the following: "top of lowest finished basement" or "bottom of lowest horizontal structural member of the reference level floor."

A diagram is provided to illustrate the various situations that may be encountered. For property locations in Flood Zones AH and A (with BF), elevation of the lowest finished basement should be reported from the top of the reference level floor. The property boundaries on zones V1, V30, V1, and V (with BF), Line 3 of the Elevation Certificate indicates that the elevation should be measured from the bottom of the lowest horizontal structural member of the reference level floor.

The agent will determine the measurement using the "top of the lowest finished basement" or "bottom of lowest horizontal structural member of the reference level floor" diagrams.



The reference level elevation may be reported to the same level of precision used to report base flood elevation on the FIRM map. If the base flood elevation is shown to the nearest half foot, the reference level may be reported to the nearest half foot.

The base flood elevation is shown on the community's Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) for zones A1, A30, AH, AP, and V. Base flood elevations may also be on EIR with the community for zones A, and V. For structures with finished basements greater than 50 feet or 15 stories, the elevation is the lesser of the above. For more information see FEMA Circular 31, 1974.

Depth of water numbers are shown on the community's Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) for zones A1, A30, and V. The depth of water numbers are used to compare with the depth of water shown on the Elevation Certificate in Line 2 of the Elevation Certificate.

Elevation reference marks other than those shown on the FIRM may be used for reference level elevation. If the community is experiencing ground subsidence, the agent should use adjusted reference marks. Adjusted reference marks should be determined by geotechnical means and shown on the FIRM as shown in the diagram. The agent should use the adjusted reference marks in the comment section.


