An inspection by our Division has determined this property is in violation of Bay County Code Section 17-2 – Prohibitions in the form of junk, trash, furniture, unscreened/unused personal property and overgrowth.

The following action must be taken to correct the above stated violation(s):

- 1. All junk, trash and furniture must be removed from the property and disposed of lawfully.
- 2. All overgrown grass or weeds must be cut or mowed.
- 3. All unscreened, unused personal property must be screened, properly stored, or removed from the property.

This correspondence will serve as official notification that the above stated violation must be corrected before November 28, 2022.

This case is scheduled to be presented to a special magistrate at the hearing on December 1, 2022, at 9:00 a.m., at the Bay County Government Center located at 840 W. 11<sup>th</sup> St., Panama City, Florida. If found in violation, the magistrate may order that the violations be corrected. Fines, liens or special assessments may be placed on the property for non-compliance and/or the costs of abatement by the County.
