An inspection by our Division has determined that this property is in violation of Bay County Land Development Regulations Chapter 4, Section 405 and Bay County Code Section 17-2 – Prohibitions in the form of storage of vehicles (recreational vehicle), vehicles, personal property, trash and junk.

The following actions must be taken to correct the above stated violations:

- 1. You are hereby notified to remove all vehicles, including recreational vehicles, from the property.
- 2. All trash, debris, junk, appliances and personal property must be removed from the property and disposed of lawfully.

This correspondence will serve as official notification that the above stated violation must be corrected by January 30, 2023.

This case is scheduled to be presented to a special magistrate at the hearing on February 2, 2023 at 9:00 a.m., at the Bay County Government Center located at 840 W. 11th St., Panama City, Florida. If found in violation, the magistrate may order that the violations be corrected. Fines, liens or special assessments may be placed on the property for non-compliance and/or the costs of abatement by the County.
