Refunding of Permit Fees: 50% of the paid permit fee may be refunded provided no inspections have been made.

Credit Card use convenience fee: 2.70 Percent (2.70%) of amount charged.

State Surcharges: Department of Community Affairs Surcharge: 1.00 Percent (1.00%) with a minimum charge of \$2.00 for each permit. This applies to all building permit types, except Manufactured Homes.

Department of Business & Professional Regulation Surcharge: 1.50 Percent (1.50%) with a minimum charge of \$2.00 for each permit. This applies to all building permit types, except Manufactured Homes.

Conflicts: When the Applicant declared value and the building valuation data table are in conflict, the permit will be based on the higher of the two values. Permits for structures and renovations of nature that do not have a square foot floor area will be based on the contractor's cost.

Insufficient Funds: Applicants shall have 15-days from the date of notice to tender payment in the full amount of the insufficiently funded check plus a service charge of \$25 if the face value does not exceed \$50; \$30 if the face value exceeds \$50 but does not exceed \$300; \$40 if the face value exceeds \$300, or; 5-percent of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.

Items not listed: Any building permit application type and Scope of Work not stated herein shall be charged a minimum Plan Review Fee of \$90 and the Building Permit Fee shall be based solely on the applicant declared value.

If an applicant uses a private provider for inspection services a 60% discount will be applied to the corresponding building permit fees.
