General:


The Bay County Solid Waste Division operates both the Bay County Steelfield Road landfill and the Bayline Drive Public Drop off Center. The Steelfield Road Landfill is the primary waste disposal facility located in Bay County. The Bayline Drive Public Drop off Center is operated in order to provide a convenient disposal option for those residents who may reside an extended distance from the Steelfield Road landfill. The facility is not a full service facility. It has limited capacity and is limited to the acceptance of small loads of materials from residential customers. Customers with large loads, or bulky materials that need to be weighed or otherwise unacceptable waste will be directed to the Steelfield Road Landfill.

Rules for Use:

- The use of this facility is restricted to Bay County Residents (proof of residency required), such as homeowners and tenants, for hauling acceptable materials from their primary residence.
- This facility may NOT be used by any commercial businesses, or anyone who has been contracted or paid to do hauling for someone else. Any person who accepts compensation for clean-up, hauling, disposal, etc., of solid waste is deemed a commercial operation. This includes landlords and apartment managements, and residents hauling other than typical household waste (as determined by the County).
- Residence Vehicles, including vans and pickups (one ton or less) may use the facility with the following exceptions:
 - a. Commercial vehicles including Uhauls
 - b. Vehicle/Trailers/Pick-up trucks with beds longer than eight (8) foot.
 - c. Vehicle/Trailers/Pick-ups with beds wider than six (6) foot.
 - d. Vehicles/trailers/Pick-up trucks with dumping beds/bodies.
 - e. Vehicles with trailers with more than one axle, or loads exceeding the height of the vehicle pulling it.

Acceptable materials and quantities. Residents are limited to the disposal of a small load of materials. A small load is defined as one that would fit into a standard size pickup truck bed.



The facility will accept small loads of the following materials:

1. Household Garbage, e.g. kitchen type garbage.
2. Small Furniture, e.g. chair, small dresser, coffee table
3. Metals, e.g. Barbeque grills (no propane tanks), bicycles, sporting equipment, etc.

Unacceptable Materials:

1. Hazardous Substances and liquids of any type, e.g., paint, paint thinner, motor oil, antifreeze, acids, caustics, pesticides, chemicals, etc.
2. Batteries, other than dry cell batteries such as AAA, AA, C and D cell batteries.
3. Flammable materials of any type. [e.g. no acetylene bottles, small propane tanks from camping stoves, Freon tanks, oxygen tanks, carbon dioxide cylinders, or helium tanks].
4. Appliances e.g. washer/dryer, dishwasher, refrigerator, oven, microwave oven
5. Automobiles, or automobile parts.
6. Tires of any size
7. Drums or tanks of any size
8. Animal carcasses.
9. Asbestos in any form, including shingles.
10. Yard waste e.g. leaves, branches, shrubbery, tree trunks or stumps of any size.
11. Mattress of any size
12. Large Furniture e.g. sofa, love seat, large table, large dresser
13. Any other waste deemed unacceptable for environmental, safety, or operational reasons by the County or its authorized agents.

Acceptance of waste is up to the discretion of the scale attendant on duty. They will determine if the material and quantity is acceptable at this facility.
