

RESOLUTION 4239

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, MODIFYING RESOLUTION 4219 RELATED TO FEES AND CHARGES FOR PERMIT APPLICATIONS, AND ACTIVITIES RELATED THERETO; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A SUNSET PROVISION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution 4219 provided for a temporary reduction in certain fees and charges for building permit applications; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizenry to modify the reductions provided in Resolution 4219; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida:

SECTION 1. RECITALS. The above recitals are hereby incorporated herein by this reference and are deemed a material part of this resolution.

SECTION 2. SCHEDULE OF FEES. The surcharge provided in Section 553.721 will continue to be calculated based on the amounts in the fee and fine schedule without regard to this temporary discount. All other building permit fees will be temporarily discounted by 60% from the amounts otherwise provided in the fee and fine schedule, including any existing discounts provided under sec. 553.791, F.S..

SECTION 3. CONFLICT. All Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent necessary to give this Resolution full force and effect.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Resolution are severable. If any word, sentence, clause, phrase or provision of this Resolution for any reason is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and portions of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM. This resolution shall be effective ten days after passage.


