





Florida Coastal Zone Criteria

- Be Hydraulically Stable Under Normal Conditions
- No Shoreline Stabilization
- Restore Water Quality
- No Adverse Impact
- Provide Public Benefit

CURRENT STATUS

- Federal Government – No Action until EIS Complete
- Florida DEP – No Action until Florida Coast Zone Protection Act is met (Inlet Management Plan and satisfy Coastal Zone Criteria)
- Estimated Cost is \$1 Million (ACOE)
- Local Funds are not available
- Mobile Army Corp of Engineers could conduct EIS & IMP
- Federal funding for re-opening may be available depending on the outcome of the EIS & IMP
- Next Phase is Design and Permitting



Restore Committee Restoration Plan Goals & Objectives

- Economic Development and Job Creation
 - Recreation , public transportation and opportunities for wage improvement
 - Conserve and protect natural resources
 - Promote recreation Gulf fishing
- Environment
 - Improve and protect the St. Andrew Bay Watershed

 - Protect seagrass beds
 - Preserve and restore dune systems and living shorelines
 - Continue to the protection and recovery of protected species
